



## 2011 Looking Glass Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc



Marlborough had been fortunate to enjoy great weather during vintage to produce good yields, and high quality Sauvignon Blanc.

This year's wines are intense, defined, classic Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc.

The 2011 Looking Glass is a true expression of the grape, and the region.

30% of the grapes were grown in the Wairau Valley, 70% in the more southern Awatere Valley. The nose has a variety of aromas; stone fruits, peach and nectarines, herbs, spearmint, and spice.

The complexity follows through to the palate with additional flavours of pears, greengage with maritime Marlborough minerality. The wine has a full rich body, and a lingering, subtle, yet intense fruit finish.
