

Looking Glass Wines 2012 New Releases

2012 Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc

2012 is the fifth vintage for Looking Glass Wines.

This year's vintage has been lighter in Marlborough, with many growers enjoying a long cool vintage, with mid-season rains. Those who picked later also benefited from the sunniest April in 18 years. The dry conditions, along with the cool autumn nights, and lesser tonnes have produced rich varietal wines. Total tonnes were nearly 20 percent down on the previous year.

The grapes have been blended from the Marlborough regions of Wairau Brancott, Northern and Southern Awatere Valleys. The areas vary with microclimate, rainfall, soil type and temperature.

The style of the Sauvignon Blanc has developed to be complex, intensely flavoured, full bodied with fresh lively acidity. Aromatics, and flavours of lime zest, passionfruit, green leaf, tropical and stone fruits are evident.

The acid levels are balanced with rich, concentrated flavours. The wine is vibrant with lovely length of flavours.

The wine style is perfect with antipastos, summer salads and seafoods.
